

WINTER NOTES 2023 ON THE LITURGICAL SEASON

The Christian Year

The Christian year tells the Story of God's Salvation. It is anchored by Christmas and Easter – God comes and God saves. These great demonstrations of God's saving power are preceded by seasons of preparation, Advent and Lent and followed by seasons of proclamation, Epiphany and Ordinary Time. That pattern of preparation, revelation, proclamation (marked with the colors purple, white and green) help us keep God-time, centering our lives around the Good News of Jesus.


Advent

The Christian New Year begins on December 3rd this year. Advent is the paradoxical season:

While the world looks backwards in manufactured nostalgia for a past that was never really ours, the church looks forward to a world to come. The Advent paradoxes of suffering and hope; darkness and light; the now and not-yet beckon us to abandon scurrying about to wait and pray. Our waiting and praying in Advent conspire against the principalities and powers that hold the world in its' grip. Simplify your holiday expectations in order to be present to God and others. And remember how the story ends: "And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory." (Luke 21:27)

Christmas and Epiphany

Christmas begins sundown Christmas Eve and lasts for twelve days. After that we proclaim the coming of our Savior in the Season after







being set by the lunar calendar. Feasts in vertical, fasts in italic.

the Epiphany. Epiphany, Greek for "appearance," proclaims the Savior's big reveal. Today an "Epiphany" is an "Aha!" moment - like when you get another piece of the puzzle that makes the whole picture make sense. This season starts with the arrival of the Magi on January 6th, followed by the Baptism of our Lord. Then we recount the early ministry of Jesus, the one who makes the puzzle of our lives make sense. The Season after the Epiphany ends with the Transfiguration of our Lord.

Lent

Lent is Spring Training for the Christian Life! The ancient season of preparing those embracing the Christian faith for Baptism (called catechumens) begins 40 days before Easter with Ash Wednesday. This year Ash Wednesday is February 14, 2024. We have services at

6:30am, noon and 6:30pm.
